## RIVERDALE UNIFORM POLICY

**Purpose:** Outline and describe the uniform for Riverdale R – 7 School students

**Context:** Riverdale has had a school uniform for a number of years. Students currently wear a range of jumpers / jackets that are not a part of the uniform. The uniform is not fully enforced.

### Uniform Expectations:

- School tops – short or long sleeve polo shirt or t-shirt to be bottle green (tank tops or sleeveless items are not acceptable)
- School jumpers or jackets to be bottle green (logos no larger than a 50 cent piece)
- Black or navy blue pants / shorts only (shorts must be to the knee)
- Sand shoes or sandals only ( thongs, heels or slip-ons are not acceptable)
- Studs or sleepers for ear rings (as dangling items may be caught and cause injury)
- Green bucket hat must be worn during playtimes, PE and outside activities
- Year 7 tops and jumpers as designed by the year 7 cohort
- Student are encouraged to have long hair tied back

<p><b>Staff</b> Enforce the uniform Conduct daily checks Send notes home if students are not in uniform</p>	<p><b>School</b> Provide spare uniform for students to wear if they come to school out of uniform</p>
